What is Adventure Playground?

Adventure Playground is an enclosed area set aside for children to develop their own playground. It offers, with friendly supervision, the opportunity for children to explore environments that were once naturally available, but are now virtually nonexistent in our “urban impacted” areas. Adventure Playground allows children of all ages to explore, create, and challenge themselves. It is a “living playground,” which undergoes constant change and is never completely developed.

Activities found in our Adventure Playground include climbing, exploring, jumping, crawling, and swinging through our AP fort, tires, and Challenger rope-bridge. We also offer fort building in the off season and water activities, including a waterslide and mud pit in the summer.

Adventure Playground is located within University Community Park, which has picnic tables and play areas for large groups if you would like to bring lunches or snacks. Adult chaperones will be required to supervise their children in the park changing areas & restrooms and may be asked to assist with facility clean-up.

ALL Children & Adults MUST **Wear Close-Toed Shoes.**

(Lace-up shoes are highly recommended)

Sandals/Aqua shoes are unacceptable. Any patrons entering Adventure Playground with inappropriate shoes will result in that person being **UNABLE** to participate in any activity for the entire day.



Bring Old Clothes

It is recommended that participants bring old clothes that can get muddy, as well as a change of clothes to go home in. We suggest an extra pair of shoes and a beach towel.



From the 405 fwy north bound turn left on Culver,
From the 405 fwy south bound turn right on Culver.

First Signal turn left on Michelson.

At first stop sign turn right at Sandburg.

The first left street, turn left on Lexicon.

Go all the way to the end and turn right into parking lot.
