

Professional Dress Attire

When turning in the job application or during the interview, it is **IMPORTANT** for the applicant to dress professionally and appropriately. Basic dress attire for both genders:



Clean and polished shoes

Nicely cleaned and trimmed nails

No visible tattoos

Minimal cologne and perfume

Do not chew gum or candy

Do not wear bright colored clothing

Specifically for MEN:

Nice khakis, slacks, or dress pants

Do not wear extremely baggy clothes

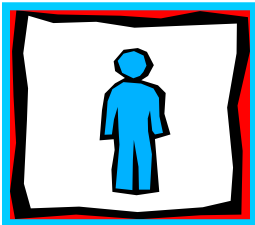
Dress shoes are appropriate

No visible tattoos or body piercing

No tennis shoes or sneakers

A button-up or collared shirt

Trimmed and combed hair



Specifically for WOMEN:

Nice dress pants or skirt

Skirts should be an inch below the knee

No visible body piercing beyond the ear

Minimal makeup and jewelry

Pantyhose is desired but not necessary for long skirts

No sleeveless shirts, tank tops, mid-riffs, spaghetti straps or low-cut shirts.

A shirt with minimal design and pattern is best.
